Mindful of Circular no 004/CAB/PM of 10th February 2000 relating to admission into National Training Colleges and recruitment into the Public Service;

The Vice Chancellor of The University of Bamenda hereby announces as follows:

Article 1: Admission is open to Private Candidates for the **year one of the First Cycle and year one of the Second Cycle** of the Higher Teacher Training College Bambili of The University of Bamenda, for the **2025/2026** Academic Year following the conditions and modalities prescribed in the present Decision.

Article 2: The Departments and number of places are presented on Table 1:

Article 3: The admission is opened to Cameroonians and foreigners of both sexes following the minimum admission qualifications stipulated below:

(1) For the First Cycle

- a) Holders of GCE/AL, in at least two (02) subjects including the major subject of the department and of GCE/OL in at least four (04) subjects including the major subject of the department and excluding Religious Knowledge;
- b) Holders of the *Baccalauréat* and *Probatoire* or any equivalent diploma recognised by the Ministry of Higher Education, with a pass in the major subject of the department;
- c) Holders of any equivalent diploma recognised by the Ministry of Higher Education.
- d) The department of Bilingual Letters shall be open to holders of GCE/AL in French with at least a "C" grade or *Baccalauréat* A4 with an average of at least 12/20 in English, fulfilling the rest of the conditions stipulated in the present Decision.
- e) The department of French Modern Letters shall be open to **holders of *Baccalauréat* A4**, fulfilling the rest of the conditions stipulated in the present Decision.
- f) Holders of foreign diplomas/certificates shall be eligible only if they submit either the equivalence or the receipt showing that they have applied for the equivalence of their diplomas or

certificates. The Order granting equivalence and the receipt are issued by the Ministry of Higher Education. The final admission of such candidates shall be confirmed upon presentation of the Text granting them equivalence, within the deadline set by the competent authorities.

g) Table 2 shows the subject(s) a candidate must pass in the GCE A/L or the *Baccalauréat* to be qualified for admission in a given programme:

(2) For the Second Cycle

a) General Teacher Education (**DIPES II and DIPEN**) Candidates must be holders of a Bachelor Degree or *Licence* in the teaching subject of the department, Bachelor of Education (B.Ed) or *Licence en Sciences de l'Education* in the teaching subject of the department. For the department of Philosophy candidates must be holders of a Bachelor Degree in Philosophy, Psychology, Anthropology and/or Sociology, or Theology.

b) Counsellor Education (**DIPCO II**) Candidates must be holders of a Bachelor Degree or *Licence* in Guidance & Counselling, Psychology, Special needs Education, Sociology, Law, Anthropology, Science of Education and Philosophy.

- c) An equivalent diploma recognised by the Ministry of Higher Education and relevant to the department of the candidate's interest may be considered. Each candidate must consult Table 2 to determine his/her eligibility prior to undertaking the registration process.
- d) Holders of foreign diplomas/certificates shall be eligible only if they submit either the equivalence or the receipt showing that they have applied for the equivalence of their diplomas or certificates. The Order granting equivalence and the receipt are issued by the Ministry of Higher Education. The final admission of such candidates shall be confirmed upon presentation of the Text granting them equivalence, within the deadline set by the competent authorities.

Article 4: The candidate's application file shall comprise of the following documents:

- An application form downloaded from <http://httcambili.com/>
- A typed certified true-copy of the Birth Certificate dated not more than six (6) months.
- A photocopy of the candidate's Birth Certificate.
- Candidates for admission into **year one of the first cycle** must provide:
 - (i) A certified copy of GCE O/L Certificate (or Results Slip) or *Probatoire* certificate (or *relevés de notes*) dated not more than six (6) months;
 - (ii) A certified copy of GCE A/L Certificate (or Results Slip) or *Baccalauréat* certificate (or *relevés de notes*) or any equivalent diploma.
- Candidates for admission into **year one of the second cycle** must provide:
 - (i) Transcripts of levels, I, II and III of the Bachelor Degree or *Licence* results, certified by **A competent Academic Authority of the candidate's University**;
 - (ii) A certified copy of the Bachelor Degree or *Licence* certified by the competent Academic Authority.
- A Medical Certificate issued by a state medical officer attesting to the candidate's physical fitness to teach.
- A Certificate of disability for physically challenged applicants.
- A receipt upon payment of twenty thousand (20,000) FCFA as non-refundable application fee issued by the Finance Office of HTTC, (No other form of payment shall be accepted)
- A letter of sponsorship from a **verifiable accredited Private Educational Institution**
- Two passport-size photographs
- An attestation of, or a receipt showing application for equivalence for candidates with a foreign certificate
- An A4 stamped self-addressed envelope
