DECISION N° **18250479** MINESUP/SG/DAUQ/SDEAC OF **22 JUL 2025**

To launch the **Competitive Entrance Examination** and set the **number of places** into **year one** of the **Higher Institute of Transport and Logistics (HITL)** of The University of Bamenda for the **2025/2026** academic year.

THE MINISTER OF STATE, MINISTER OF HIGHER EDUCATION:

Mindful of Decree N° 93/026 of 19th January 1993 to create Universities;
Mindful of Law N°. 2023/007 of 25 July 2023 Orientating the Higher Education in Cameroon;
Mindful of Decree N° 93/027 of 19th January 1993 laying down common provisions in State Universities, modified and supplemented by Decree No 2005/342 of 10th September 2005;
Mindful of Decision N° 004/CAB/PM of 10th February 2000 on admission into national schools of training and recruitment of civil servants;
Mindful of Decision N° 2010/371 of 14 December 2010 fixing the applicable regime to the University;
Mindful of Decree N° 2010/371 of 14th December 2010 to create The University of Bamenda;
Mindful of Decree N° 2010/372 of 14th December 2010 to erect the Higher Institute of Transport and Logistics;
Mindful of Decree N° 2011/045 of 08th March 2011 to organize the University of Bamenda;
Mindful of Decree N° 2011/408 of 09th December 2011 to organize the Government;
Mindful of Decree N° 2011/410 of 09th December 2011 to appoint members of Government;
Mindful of Decree N° 2012/433 of 1st October 2012 to organize the Ministry of Higher Education;
Mindful of Decree N° 2015/541 of 27th November 2015 appointing the Vice Chancellor of The University of Bamenda;
Mindful of Decree N° 2019/447 of 27th August 2019 appointing the Director of The Higher Institute of Transport and Logistics;
Mindful of Decision N° 18250145 MINESUP/SG/DAUQ/SDEAC of 07th April 2025 fixing the calendar for competitive entrance in Schools of State Universities of Cameroon and Schools under academic management of MINESUP, for the 2025/2026 academic year.

HEREBY DECIDES AS FOLLOWS:

Article 1: A competitive entrance examination into year one of the Higher Institute of Transport and Logistics (HITL), of the University of Bamenda, for the 2025/2026 academic year has been launched in the following 6 Departments:

- Article 2:** (1) The examination shall be organized in one sitting to holders of 2 GCE A/L papers or Baccalauréat of adequate series or any equivalent diploma recognised by the Ministry of Higher Education in addition to 4 GCE O/L papers or Probatoire with a pass in English. **However, candidates who did not have a pass in English at O/L could be admitted after attending and passing the intensive English course organised by The University of Bamenda at the beginning of each Academic Year;**
- (2) Article 3 below shows the required diplomas or certificates a candidate **must have** to be qualified to register for the competitive entrance into a given Department.

- Article 3:** An application file shall comprise the following documents:
- Registration form of the Higher Institute of Transport and Logistics duly filled to be accessed online from website at www.hitlbamenda.cm.
 - A certified copy of birth certificate dated not more than six (6) months;
 - A certified photocopy of GCE O/L or Probatoire dated not more than six (06) months;
 - A certified photocopy of GCE A/L or Baccalauréat or equivalent diploma dated not more than six (6) months;
 - Certified photocopies of GCE O/L and GCE A/L or Probatoire and Baccalauréat transcripts;
 - A medical certificate of fitness which is less than three (03) months old issued by a Doctor of the Public Service;
 - A receipt upon payment of twenty thousand (20,000) FCFA as non-refundable registration fees paid into the bank account number of The Higher Institute of Transport and Logistics in NFC bank (Acct. No. **100250003216201050747-67**)
 - Two coloured passport-size photographs,
 - Upon admission, candidates are expected to present their original certificates.

Article 4: Complete files should be submitted at the HITL secretariat Bamenda or at the examination centres indicated in Article 6 below latest **September 23RD, 2025** by noon.

Article 5: The competitive entrance examination shall comprise:

- 1) A written examination counting for 70% of the final mark,
- 2) An assessment of the candidate's previous academic work based on transcript results for 30%. *VP*

Article 6: The written examination shall take place on **September 23rd, 2025** in the six centres of Bafoussam, Bambili, Buea, Douala and Yaounde;

Article 7: The syllabus of the written examination is the same as in the Baccalauréat or GCE A/L corresponding programmes.

Article 8: Marks for each paper of the written tests range from **zero (0) to 100**. Any candidate who scores less than **20** out of **100** shall be disqualified.

Article 9: i) Questions will cover General Knowledge, English, French, Economics or Mathematics.
ii) Questions on the general paper shall comprise programs of the five departments of Customs, Land Transport, Maritime Transport, Tourism and Hospitality Management and Transit/Logistics.

The examination structure is indicated as follows:

- **Paper I (Major)** 2 hours Coefficient 4: Mathematics OR Economics
- **Paper II (Minor)** 2 hours Coefficient 2: General Knowledge, English and French

Article 10: After the test, the jury shall prepare the lists of successful candidates per Department and by alphabetical order for publication by the Minister of state, Minister of Higher Education;

Article 11: The composition of the jury mentioned in the above article is specified by the Minister of state, Minister of Higher Education.

Article 12: The Vice Chancellor of The University of Bamenda, the Director of University Accreditations and Quality at the Ministry of Higher Education, and the Director of the Higher Institute of Transport and Logistics (HITL) are, each in his own sphere, responsible for the implementation of this decision which shall be registered and published in English and in French whenever necessary.
